METHODS

- PENCIL DRAWING, PEN & INK
- COLOURED PENCILS 
- PAINTING WITH WATER COLOURS, ACRYLICS OR GOUACHE (Push!)

- WAX RESIST: drawing with wax (crayons or candles) & then painting over with water colours. SHARPIES (FELT TIP PENS).....

MATERIALS

All you need is a pencil or a pen, to get started. The rest you can improvise (make up as you go along) You can make glue paste from flour & water. Scissors or tearing, (and chappatis too) that is the question? If you do run out of card, and are desperate - cut up the cereal box and use that!!!

Cutting pictures out of magazines & newspapers. JUXTAPOSING (Good Word)

Using mags & newspapers as a source of colour, collecting up the colours, tearing, cutting, sticking and glueing like you would using paints.



* MIX UP YOUR MEDIA *

Collage with found items such as labels, bus tickets, textiles (fabric, cotton, string) Wire, feathers and leaves; Arrange - compose. Anything that will tell a story, a narrative. Be funny! Seriously.

CUT OUTS

Cut coloured paper or tear it, to make your design (like Matisse) or use shapes to make abstract art.



use tissue paper overlaying it for a range of colours.

Spend as little or as much time as you want on each postcard!
